



Please turn in by March 27, 2024 as the scheduling meeting with the league will take place in April. Failure to sign up on time will result in a \$100 late fee charge.


If you are signing up a 4th grade student, please note that it has not been determined they will be playing. 4th graders only play if there are not enough players.
